
(Hemicentetes semispinosus)

Stridulation rubs parts of its body together emitting electric current sounds to communicate with teammates 20 damage

Bucking raise quills and violently bucks head at opponent 10 damage

When cold out these Pokémon conserve heat by reducing body temperature to match the airs. Enters a deep sleep when too cold to function. LV. 14 *25


Lowland streaked tenrecs lack spines, this will develop once he's born


Weaning

A Lowland Streaked Tenrec can live up to 2.6 years, making him a great Pokémon companion! You're most likely to catch one during their mating season September-December. Only catch it if it is sexually mature, or 25 days old. You should also know that their biggest Weakness is habitat loss.
